- 2. Greetings from Councilor Wilson's Ward 1 office: Stephanie Hilson gave report as Councilor Wilson attending City Council meeting tonight.
 - a) Reservoir work at the "Rez" completed. Stairs not "user friendly" and will be replaced with other landscaping features. Money approved in budget.
 - b) Aberdeen Ave. street calming project is continuing.
 - c) Queen St. Conversion to 2 way upgrades approved with extension to King St.
 - d) Locke St. construction has commenced and will continue to November. Concern raised about high levels of dust. Project Manager is aware.
 - e) Cindy Stranak leaving Ward 1 office position April 30. Thank you Cindy for your hard work and assistance in this role.
- 3. Police update: Acting/Sgt David Brewster is our new liaison officer for Ward 1. Report given on # of calls for service from Jan-April 2019 and breakdown of reasons for calls to police. Mainly B&Es and auto mischief or theft. No graffiti reported. Lock it or Lose it program available to neighbourhood if requested. Concern raised about "bush parties" at the Rez. Residents encouraged to call police if needed.
