- Received 283 responses to survey
- Mark working on categorizing results from survey, what people are interested in.
- Some suggestions from survey results aren't activities we are involved in (eg.- How tax dollars are spent, emergency response support).
- Majority of people are hearing about our events through KNA emails and KNA social media
- Almost half of respondents are age 55 and older
- Compost sale and pumpkin sale are most popular KNA events among respondents
